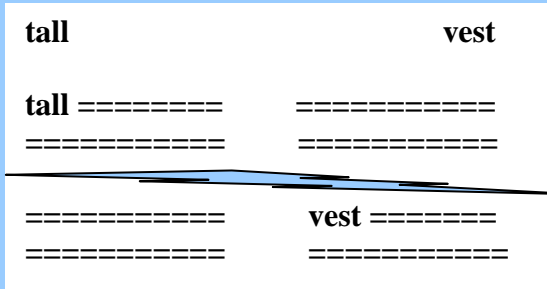

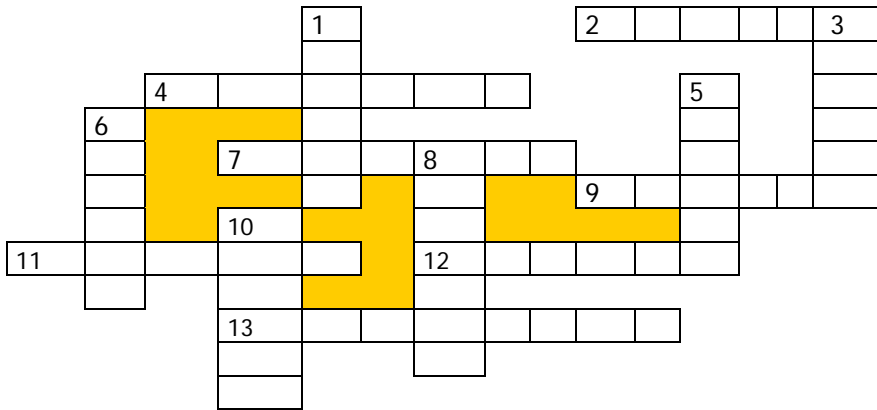

Past tense of final y words

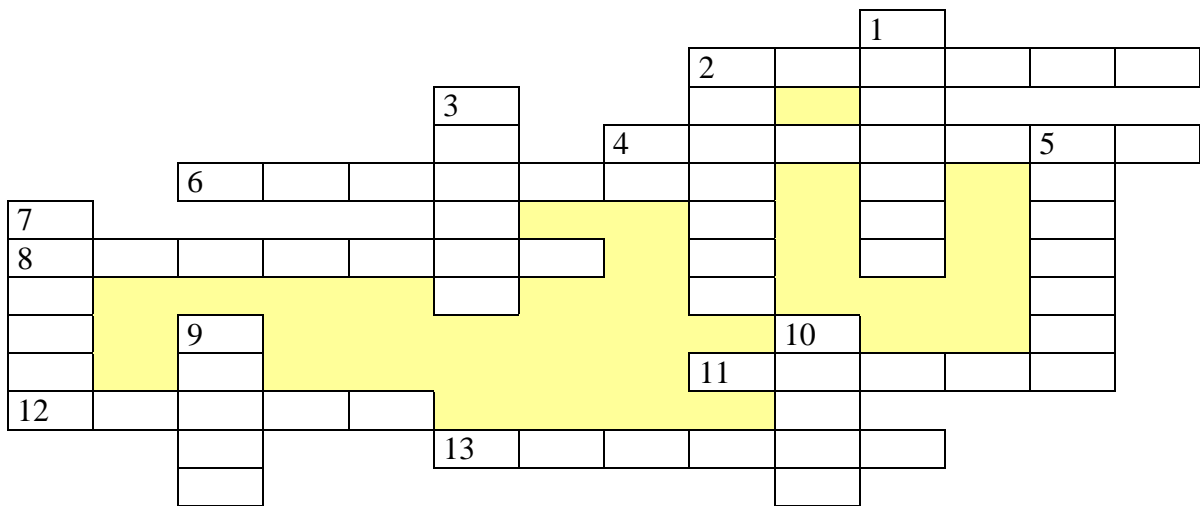
When a verb ends with **vowel + y**, add the ending **ed** to make the past tense.
